CO/CMC Conference 8-9 October – The conference will be held at the Shifting Sands Complex, Dam Neck, VA. Start time on 8 October is 1300 and end time will be 1600 on 9 October. A follow on meeting for Provisional Center and TSC COs/CMCs will be hosted by CAPT Fred Bertsch on 10-11 October at the same location.

Functional Integration Manager (FIM) – On 18 September, FIM began conducting a series of 2-day workshops with Center Directorate Managers. These workshops focus on standardizing processes across all Centers.
