### News You Can Use

**Center for Naval Engineering (CNE):** Basic Engineering Core Course pilot was launched 3 March with 23 students. CNE is working with ATG, Fleet and OPNAV N132 representatives to design a plan for evaluating the course's effectiveness through graduates' at sea performance. OPNAV N132 selecting students for Beta 2. The course outlines are now completed for Engineering Operator, Advanced Operator and Manager curricula.

**Center Services Support(CSS):** Conducted the MS JTA scoping meeting on 13 March 2003. The JTA working group meeting is scheduled for 24-28 Mar 2003. CSS is currently testing the American Culinary Federation accepted CBTs for content. Conducted 3M Pilot course. After reviewing pilot results and implementing recommended course changes, CSS plans to implement course in Norfolk and San Diego in April.

**Center for Naval Leadership (CNL):** Harvard Manage Mentor Plus leadership development resource is now available on NKO. Realignment of both Officer and Enlisted Leadership Training Courses (LTC) to the Naval Leadership Competency Model and performance requirements continue. LPO and LCPO pilot courses conducted 18-28 Feb 03. Instructor Training (IT) pilot course concept under development.

**Center for Information Technology (CIT):** CIT is currently executing POA&M for IP Officer basic course and is in the process of purposing ISSM Course to reusable learning object (RLO) format. IT Sea Warrior Prototype Working Group held initial meeting 5 March to identify requirements to begin building an automated 5VM. The first Sea Warrior JTA development working group scheduled to meet in April.

**Center for Naval Intelligence (CNI):** IS JTA is 70% complete. CNI is now conducting a gap analysis and working with Fleet/TYCOMs for additional subject matter expert surveys. CNI is currently collecting information for civilian equivalent CERTS/QUALS. Officer 5VM/JTA coordination continues. Initial conference with CNI, Community manager, and OPNAV N2 staff scheduled for early.

**Center for Surface Operations (CSO):** Working Group #6 completed final scrub of QM and BM Jobs/Tasks, JTAs forwarded to Skills Net for development of KSAs. Reviewing additional certifications and qualifications to populate the 5 Vector Models for the ratings

**Center for Cryptology (CC):** JTAs completed for CTT, CTA, CTM, CTO, CTR, CTI, and EW. These JTAs were briefed and approved by CFFC and TYCOM. A team from the American Council on Education reviewed 23 cryptologic "A" and "C" school courses and recommended upper and lower level college credits.
